Editorial

Can you always choose the "quality of time"? Certainly not. A life-threatening operation cannot be postponed to a time that is more harmonious. The same applies to the birth of a human being. What you can't choose, people used to like to call fate. But one can take a close look at what causes this increased disharmony in time and, if necessary, take countermeasures. Crises, even personal ones, cannot be avoided, but they can be mitigated if the causes are known.

Thus, the Great Disharmony of 2045 need not be the beginning of a Dark Age. Any of the Apocalyptic Horsemen who visibly herald this Great Crisis can also be appeased if one wants to.

Children can be daredevils or try to avoid any risk. Can risk-taking be favored one way or the other by the planetary gravitational field at birth?

What awaits young people in the 3rd Jupiter growth cycle? In the Biographical Rhythms we will explore this question and discuss the harmonies and disharmonies to be expected.

Harmony and disharmony March 2023

First, let's look at harmony and disharmony:




Figure 1; The quality of time in March 2023; Full Moon is on the 7th, New Moon on the 21st.

The first half of March (until the 12th of the month) is subject to an alternation of harmony and disharmony, with the harmonic phases predominating. This moodiness is dominated by the Moon, accept it, you know what can be the cause. What's going on in the early morning of March 15?

The superposition of the Sun, Moon, Mercury, Mars and Pluto results in this minimum, indicating a high propensity for instability. In conjunction with the curve progression through March 18, this time certainly has the potential to trigger instability, disharmony. If tensions already exist, they may be amplified and erupt during this time. Avoid making decisions during this time, you may be mistaken (disharmonious Neptune). Avoid aggressive actions (disharmonious Mars). Stay friendly, harmonious Venus will help you in the beginning and may be able to prevent escalation with you. From March 18, a harmonious period begins, if they have previously coped well with the cliff of disharmony. However, it will be vibrated by the Moon at the end of the month.

Always remember that already Kepler had the view: "The stars make inclined, they do not force." With today's knowledge, we can say, "The constellations of the planets change the probability of harmony and stability." (A brief summary of the effect of the planets (their frequencies) can be found in the 2023-01 issue in the block "Astrological Primordial Principles" on page 3).




Figure 2; The energy of the quality of time in March 2023

Evolution is a constant change between harmony and disharmony, between stability and instability. If it were not so, nothing would evolve. In a generally difficult time, one should use the harmonious times to do something that promises a little more success. It is like sailing. Those who have learned it will come through the storm better, the storm itself cannot be conjured up.

The willingness to take risks in the quality of time

A subtest (No. 12) of the intelligence test (LPS according to Prof. Horn) measures the fast guessing of garbled words. It has a high correlation (0.88) with the overall IQ test score. Observations of children for whom this factor was lowest revealed that these children were usually somewhat shy, insecure, and unwilling to take risks. Therefore, it could be conjectured that this very "risk factor" might have a correlation with a function describing stable and unstable states of structure formation. It is not clear at first whether the correlation exists for harmonic or disharmonic states.

To investigate this question, 25 children were selected from the 160 tested for whom the factor (No. 12) had the relatively lowest values of the entire achievement test.




Figure 1; IQ test with subtest 12 "Making decisions; degree of certainty; willingness to take risks".

The results for the various orders of the correlation function are shown in Table 1.

From Table 1, first important conclusions can be drawn regarding the interpretation of the correlation function with respect to the structuring of personality factors. If we assume that the

children are less willing to take risks than the statistical mean, then the positive correlation with the "harmonious" values of the correlation function indicates that these children have a predisposition for harmony and they avoid processes that can lead to disharmony, which can always be the case with higher risk.

These are only initial hypotheses, and further research needs to follow. It is interesting that the significant results are obtained for the small orders of the correlation function. This suggests a larger period around birth, which could be of influence in this particular case.

Which oscillators contribute significantly to this harmony?

It can be seen from Table 1 that the correlation function H has a maximum for the 2nd order. This shows that certain frequencies have a dominant significance. On the other hand, if we look at the first derivative D, the correlation is greatest for the 5th order.




Figure 2: differentiated influence of the oscillators (planets) for the 2nd order of the correlation function. Very unusual is the high harmony of the planets Moon, Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter and Saturn.

This means that also the change of the correlation function in a small period around the birth is not to be neglected. Since in the table 1 all 10 celestial bodies with relevant gravitational influence were considered, the question naturally arises whether all these celestial bodies are also of influence in this case. The correlation matrix shows, and this is quite to be expected, not for all 10 celestial bodies the same importance. Especially of influence are the moon, Venus, Mars, Jupiter and Saturn.

If only these planets are admitted to the correlation, then the following result is given in table 2.

According to Table 2, the probability of error for the statement:

"Children with a relatively low performance of the IQ factor guessing mutilated words (risk factor) have particularly harmonious correlations of Moon, Venus, Mars, Jupiter and Saturn at birth", less than 0.005% ! These children are thus born in a particularly harmonious time and will always strive for harmony in their later life and will show very little willingness to take risks.

Of course, further optimizations of the correlation of the 10 celestial bodies can be carried out. However, this would go beyond the scope of this publication. It should be shown here only that optimizations, which do not change the correlation function, already bring clearly better correlations, which can be used then also practically.

The above example shows how and in which direction further investigations are to be connected. The correlations contain a large number of the most different frequencies, which can all be examined for their special effect and meaning. The rough selection of the frequencies can be done by the correlating celestial bodies and by the order of the correlation function. At the same time, the large number of correlation frequencies reveals the great complexity of planetary fluctuations. Another factor for the optimization of the correlation function are the weightings of the individual celestial bodies, which was shown here only hintingly by the selection of the planets.

The 10 000 control groups of 25 events each were selected in the period from 1979 to 1989 (the birth period of these individuals). This is a relatively small period especially with respect to the "slow" major planets.

If the control groups are selected in a much larger period (1900 to 2000), the following picture emerges:

Even in the much larger time period, the pattern of correlations remains.

Summary

Children with the character traits "lack of decision-making ability", "lack of risk-taking", which correlate with the subtest of the LPS (performance testing system) "guess garbled words", have an above-average harmonious time quality at birth.

Compared to the harmonic time quality at the birth of highly gifted persons, here it is mainly additionally the moon and Venus which show a strong harmony. Thus, it can be hypothesized that the harmony of the Moon and Venus make a lack of risk-taking more likely. These individuals will place a high value on personal security in their lives.

SINGULARITY IN THE FUTURE ?

The crisis of 2045

In recent issues of "The Quality of Time," patterns for the economic and financial crises of 1929 and 2010 have been found to be very similar. Were there other times between these crises when instability and disharmony were also great?

How do the harmonics of the major planets behave in a larger period of time?

For this purpose the past100 years are calculated.

The economic and financial crises of 1929 and 2010 can be seen very clearly by the course of the growing instability up to an extreme point.




Figure 1; Harmony-Disharmony from 1921 to 2021

Figure 1. shows the results: The greatest crisis of civilization in this period was in the years 1961 to 1968, which was the height of the Cold War between the then militarily leading world powers. Besides there are still smaller time periods which show bigger disharmony. The extent to which crises were also triggered there, or whether only tensions were present, would still have to be examined in detail.

It must be emphasized again and again that the harmonics of the planets change only the probability for the stability or instability, but do not cause them causally.

Can a similarly large disharmony in the planetary rhythms be recognized for the future?




Figure 2: Time quality (harmony) from 2020 to 2050 of the planets Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Pluto.

In fact, a strong disharmony can be seen for the years 2043 to 2046. It is even the strongest disharmony of the whole century (2000 to 2100). If the oscillator Neptune, which has played only a marginal role in the financial crises, is added, the character of the crisis changes. Neptune brings a disharmonic harmonic here, suggesting that social illusions about the future may be part of this crisis (*from the experience of astrology - has not yet been scientifically proven*),




Figure 3; time quality H from 2020 to 2050 of the planets Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus Neptune and Pluto.

The year 2045 is the year of the apocalypse for the Fermi Paradox [1] and also the year of the Technological Singularity according to Raymond Kurzweil.[2].

The next 30 years will go down in history as a watershed time.

Ian Morris, in his book, "Who Rules the World? Why Civilizations Rule or Are Ruled"[1] he mentions five Apocalyptic Horsemen by name that can serve as signs of a world turning point. He arrives at these 5 cardinal signs from an analysis of the past ten thousand years of human development.

According to Ian Morris, are these horsemen really capable of ushering in an age of darkness in their entirety ?

The Apocalyptic Horsemen according to Morris are:

1. famines
2. epidemics
3. uncontrolled migration
4. political instability
5. climate change

From the experiences of the previous investigations, which are not all listed here, there is indeed an increased probability of an apocalypse due to the planetary disharmony. However, an apocalypse does not have to mean the end of mankind.

Biographical Rhythms from the 24th to the 36th year




Figure 1; The Biographical Rhythms from 24 to 36 years of age

At the age of 24 the 3rd unfolding phase in life begins, Jupiter is at the place of birth for the third time. The horizon of life has become wider. Evaluation by others, social recognition in the respective group plays an essential role for many: "How do the others see me, who likes me?" Begin self-love can also be a longer learning process and should not be confused with selfishness.

The background music is played by Venus and increasingly also by the energy planet Mars. The personality stabilizes, the position in the world becomes more secure. In this phase of life the spiritual themes (Venus) are still very much in the foreground.

The start into this stage of life is harmonious

The curves of Jupiter and Saturn are ascending, the unfolding is favored and a new overview of life is established. For this phase of life the curves already show a much stronger importance of Uranus and Neptune for the biography, whose rhythms are also in the harmonic range at the beginning of this phase of life. The superpositions of the important nodes of the planets can be seen at a glance. It is an age when both emotional and professional developments and unfoldings take place on a new level. This active period of life is initially supported by a harmonious constellation of Saturn, since Saturn forms a sextile to his natal position at about age 24. The young person is usually ready to

established. At 25, a longer harmonious period of life begins for many. The superposition curve is in the upper range until about age 29. Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune are harmonious. At age 29/30 the curve turns to disharmony, then rises again.

At 26, Jupiter is seen in slight disharmony, which is complemented by the slightly disharmonious curve of Uranus. A rapid change in Jupiter's transits is due to the fact that Jupiter moves the fastest of the major planets and only stays in one sign of the zodiac for one year at a time. This results in usual fluctuations in personal development. Weak disharmonies often bring a person into activity and to new thinking with corresponding reactions. Provided that inner development and outer life circumstances are in harmony, harmonious years now follow. The planets show with the superposition curve an active, pleasant time of life. Essential courses are set. Ideally, the personality feels "at peace with itself" and already has a good overview of life.

However, we are living in socially difficult times. The years from 2020 onwards will be dominated worldwide by crises with manifold consequences, so that the life and freedom of decision of the individual will suffer restrictions. It remains to be seen what the long-term consequences will be, because many people are currently unable to live according to the rhythms of the planets or to act in the way that would be appropriate at the time. As a compensation for the constricted life possibilities in the outside, ideally the soul developments in the "inner space" should take place more intensively.

Crises in the second half of this stage of life - quarterlife crisis

In the third twelve-year phase also again development crises are possible, you see the fluctuations of the curve of Jupiter, particularly with 24, 26, 28 and up to 30 years. Problems always occur more frequently when personal development cannot take place according to one's own ideals. It is not always easy to enter professional and social life. In addition, there are other problems at this age. Some young trainees are not taken on by the company and cannot find a job that matches their qualifications for a long time. Some young graduates have to "keep their heads above water" from one internship to the next. This makes it difficult to find a secure position. This is when young people enter the quarter-life crisis (QLC). It is a crisis that has only played a role or been studied in the psychology of adulthood for a few years.

The new orbit of Jupiter at the age of 24 makes the desire for development, for taking up a task in the professional field become urgent. If external circumstances are against it, so that no professional beginning can be found, a crisis situation (quarterlife crisis) can occur, which is intensified by financial dependence on the parental home. This is indicated by the unstable time quality of Jupiter at the beginning of this phase of life and again at about 26 years.

If one succeeds in finding one's own way at the beginning of this new growth phase, i.e. at about 24/25 years of age, the next years will be quite successful and harmonious.

Observing the biographies of personalities who became famous, essential achievements often show up in this 3rd development phase between 24 and 36 years.

Jupiter passes through a zodiac sign for one year. The harmonic and disharmonic transits to the natal position change in a quick succession. This allows difficult times to be overcome more quickly. Problems occur when the disharmonies are intensified by other planets like Saturn, Uranus or Neptune. These are then junctions in the biography.

This is also true for the harmonic periods of Jupiter. If harmonious constellations of Saturn, Uranus or Neptune come along, life runs in pleasant courses.

At present there are also more and more young people who cannot or do not want to decide on a profession and neither start an apprenticeship nor study. They do not know which profession can give meaning (Jupiter) to their life. Help can be given by an analysis of the horoscope and the individual planetary rhythms.

Look again at the 12 - year curve of the age from 24 to 36 years: You can see that the curve of Uranus at 25 is ascending and in clear harmonic range until the age of 31. Uranus forms a trine to its natal position at age 27. A subtle seeking for change, for something new, and for personal responsibility occurs. The quest for freedom is intensified. In the world of work, it is a favorable time for self-discovery and self-determination. Thoughts about one's professional career become more concrete. Strength and energy are well present in many people at this age.

Neptune and with it the family and social commitment gains importance

In the 3rd growth rhythm, Neptune, the primordial principle of reconciliation, is also already to be considered. You see the curve of Neptune in the age from 24 to 34 in a clear harmony.

This favors social processes in the family or social environment.

Neptune stands for compassion and agape (*selfless love*), for helpfulness and social commitment. Fantasy, dreams, visions are also themes of the principle Neptune. In the disharmonious realm, Neptune also stands for ambiguity, confusion, uncertain situations, deceit and deception. For one orbit around the zodiac Neptune needs 165/166 years.

The curve of Neptune is harmonious, forming a sextile to itself at the age of 27, evoking longings and unclear desires. At the same time, the curve of Jupiter is clearly disharmonious. Jupiter forms a square to itself at the age of 27. This is a growth node, which can burden development and lead to the beginning of a crisis of meaning, when the meaning of life has not yet been found or no longer seems coherent. Then follows the transition into a major life crisis, to the 1st return of Saturn to the natal position, called "Saturn Return".

The superposition curve shows these disharmonies from age 28 to 30, and again around age 33. From age 28 to about age 31, the curves of Jupiter and Saturn are in disharmonic. Jupiter runs into opposition to itself, which is mostly exact at age 30.

Saturn forms the 1st conjunction to itself, because after about 29.4 years Saturn returns to the natal position for the first time. Thus Saturn has once formed all major transits to itself. You can recognize individual deviations by your personal transits, or by looking into the ephemerides, or in your own biographical rhythms .

The age of 28 to 30 brings upheavals in many biographies. A great period of life ends. Saturn has completed its first orbit. The rhythm of Saturn is connected with the increasing maturity and thus with the aging of man. After three full Saturn orbits the human being is in old age.

You may know from yourself or from your social environment that the age around 28 to 30 years is a significant break in life.

The imparted philosophy of life of childhood and youth is questioned

It is a time in life when the values, the philosophy of life that were taught in childhood and adolescence are questioned. The backpack packed by parents, teachers and other caregivers must be reviewed and unpacked so that it can be re-stocked, now with one's own ideas and

In the fairy tale of the Frog Prince, the situation is expressed figuratively when the breaking open of the "rings around the soul" sounds so loud that the impression is created that "the chariot" (the life companion) is breaking. The fairy tale conveys that the rings around the soul must be broken open so that the personality does not remain trapped in a framework that does not belong to it.

desires about life, one's own values and ideals. Self-initiative becomes even more important.

With the 3rd opposition of Jupiter to itself (30 years) and the beginning of a new orbit of Saturn, one's own life ideas and goals come to the fore, life must be seized in the maturity of the adult himself. Therefore it seems questionable and immature to still blame the parents for one's own failures and for one's own problems at this and the coming age.

In many biographies, the age around 28 to 30 is problematic and often rich in conflict.

You see that at the age of 30 Jupiter forms a clear swing into disharmony, at the same time the curve of Saturn is elongated in the disharmonic area.

Times of disharmonious Saturn are times of crisis, the feeling of not getting ahead, of not being able to go on, dominates. A client formulated at this age, when she didn't know at all what the future could look like: "It's as if there were resistances everywhere, as if I were constantly walking over stones, and always bumping into them and hurting myself and not making any progress..."

There is a place that you have to fill that no one else can fill, and there is something for you to do that no one else can do.

Plato

Intense negative feelings are often already surfacing, which will intensify during the midlife crisis. Fears may also arise that life should now go on like this until retirement age or the end of life. "Is that supposed to be it?" A question that can already be unsettling at this stage of life. The thought of one's life's mission comes to the fore. "Who am I? What is my task?" Questions that made the searching person ponder even in ancient times. The Greek philosopher Plato was known for formulating the thoughts of his generation. His advice to the younger generation is still applicable today.

The feeling of dissatisfaction with the situation or a struggle with the life so far or what has been achieved can lead to melancholic or depressive mood. Life has reached a low point. Only something new can get the flow of life going again. The disharmony of Saturn is often so stressful that it eventually motivates to clarify difficult situations. Life structures undergo an uncomfortable transformation if no other, easier ways out are found. This is the background for development possibilities in a crisis situation.

If nothing new can be found, the affected person will stagnate in the crisis. Then he needs help. Not everyone gets out of this situation without outside help, because some do not find their way and are burdened with self-doubt. An astro-therapy would certainly be helpful, because in the horoscope indications for meaningful life tasks can be found.

The tension of Jupiter intensifies the burdening theme, but can activate to start something again, to dare a change and a new beginning. Since during the return of Saturn to the natal position (approx. 29/30 years) Jupiter is at the same time in a dynamic constellation (opposition to itself), it explains itself that this time of crisis is a great chance for something new.

The need to start a family or the decision against it

In this crisis of maturation, the need often develops to start a family or even to separate if a partnership was entered into young. Sometimes the desire for a house of one's own or for professional or spatial reorientation emerges. Once again, the personality is in search of its own talents. What has been buried under the demands of everyday life? The meaning of life wants to be grasped anew.

Carl Gustav Jung, the Swiss psychiatrist and founder of analytical psychology, believed that life

has the meaning we give it. Something becomes meaning when we make it our own task. This is preceded by a conscious decision to this task. The task of life wants to be sought and consciously grasped. Not seldom it lies visibly there, and is recognized nevertheless only over detours or by reflections by others. One can recognize life tasks particularly clearly through an analysis of the horoscope.

Since our life, as the curves of the biographical rhythms also show, fluctuates between high points and low points, moves from wave crest to wave trough and back to wave trough again, there will always be life changes and new possibilities and directions. Those who know the turning times and their characteristics can prepare themselves for coming upheavals and thus cope with them better. The major recurring rhythms that trigger crises are the overlaps of Jupiter and Saturn: after every 6 years, Jupiter comes into opposition or conjunction, complemented by the 7-year rhythm of Saturn (square, opposition, square again, and the opposition). Unfolding and stagnation are in struggle with each other and want to be led again and again to a new beginning. The rhythms of the major planets Uranus, Neptune and Pluto strengthen or reduce the upheaval situations.
